**ANNOUNCEMENT IN RELATION TO KEY OPERATIONAL DATA  
IN THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2022**

This announcement is made by China Communications Construction Company Limited (the “**Company**”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Hong Kong Laws) and Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited.

The principal operating status of the Group for the fourth quarter of 2022 is set out as below, for the purpose of reference for the investors.

**I. PRINCIPAL OPERATING STATUS**

In 2022, the Group attached great importance to the key and principal business. Adhering to the business strategy of expanding its contracting projects and strengthening its investment business, the Group strengthened smart operation and sustainable operation, concentrated on the implementation of high-quality projects and strategic key projects and achieved remarkable results in market development.

In 2022, the value of new contracts of the Group amounted to RMB1,542,256 million, representing a year-on-year increase of 21.64%, achieving 109% of the annual goal (being 11.8% of growth on the basis of the value of new contracts in 2021 amounting to RMB1,267,912 million). Wherein, the value of new contracts of infrastructure construction business, infrastructure design business, dredging business and other businesses amounted to RMB1,367,070 million, RMB54,899 million, RMB106,654 million and RMB13,633 million, respectively.

The value of new contracts of the Group in the fourth quarter amounted to RMB510,095 million, representing an increase of 95.29% and 121.53% as compared to the corresponding period of 2021 and the third quarter of 2022, respectively. The increase was mainly due to the lower than planned growth rate of new contracts in the first three quarters as the result of the epidemic, and the full liberalization of the epidemic prevention and control policy in the fourth quarter, which accelerated the landing and signing of qualified projects, thus achieving the outsized full-year growth. The business growth was mainly due to the increase in investment and construction projects such as domestic road and bridge construction, municipal engineering, integrated urban development and housing construction.

In 2022, the value of new contracts of all businesses from overseas markets amounted to RMB216,782 million (equivalent to approximately USD33,592 million), representing a year-on-year increase of 0.37%, accounting for approximately 14% of the Group's new contracts value. Wherein, the value of new contracts of infrastructure construction business, infrastructure design business, dredging business and other businesses amounted to RMB208,641 million, RMB1,358 million, RMB5,678 million and RMB1,105 million, respectively.

In 2022, the contract value of all businesses from the infrastructure and other investment projects according to shareholding ratio of the Group amounted to RMB211,658 million. During the process of design and construction, the value of construction and installation contracts to be undertaken by the Group was estimated to be RMB183,578 million (excluding projects signed by John Holland Group Pty Ltd.). In 2022, the value of investment involved in domestic infrastructure and other investment projects as approved by the Group amounted to RMB231,427 million, accounting for 83% of the annual plan.
