## **ANNOUNCEMENT IN RELATION TO KEY OPERATIONAL DATA FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2025**

This announcement is made by China Communications Construction Company Limited (the “**Company**”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Hong Kong Laws) and Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited.

The principal operating status of the Group for the fourth quarter of 2025 is set out as below, for the purpose of reference for the investors.

### **I. PRINCIPAL OPERATING STATUS**

In 2025, the value of new contracts of the Group amounted to RMB1,883,672 million, representing an increase of 0.13% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year, achieving 93% of the annual goal (representing a growth of 7.1% on the basis of the value of new contracts in 2024 amounting to RMB1,881,185 million, as considered and approved by the board of directors).

## 1. Statistics by Type of Business

By business type, the value of new contracts of infrastructure construction business, infrastructure design business, dredging business and other businesses amounted to RMB1,722,420 million, RMB42,500 million, RMB106,885 million and RMB11,867 million, respectively.

## 2. Development of “Five Wholes” Business Areas

The value of new contracts of all businesses from whole transportation, whole cities, whole water, whole green, whole digital and other sectors amounted to RMB703,314 million, RMB795,460 million, RMB141,154 million, RMB199,033 million, RMB17,825 million and RMB26,886 million, respectively.

### 3. Statistics by Geographic Region

The value of new contracts of all businesses from overseas markets amounted to RMB392,441 million (equivalent to approximately USD55,164 million), representing an increase of 9.09% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year, accounting for approximately 21% of the Group's new contracts value. Wherein, the value of new contracts of infrastructure construction business, infrastructure design business, dredging business and other businesses amounted to RMB377,791 million, RMB3,614 million, RMB9,601 million and RMB1,435 million, respectively.

### 4. Development of Emerging Business Markets

The value of new contracts of all businesses from emerging business areas represented by energy conservation and environmental protection, new energy, new materials and new-generation information technology industry amounted to RMB665,543 million, representing a decrease of 5.64% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year. Although there was a slight year-on-year adjustment, the overall scale remained substantial, accounting for 35% of the Group's total contribution, reflecting the phased achievements of the Company's transformation and development.

### 5. Development of New Business Areas Markets

In terms of all businesses, the value of new contracts from energy engineering projects amounted to RMB122,369 million, representing an increase of 50.36% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year; the value of new contracts from agriculture, forestry, animal husbandry and fishery engineering projects amounted to RMB20,062 million, representing an increase of 135.89% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year; and the value of new contracts from water conservancy projects amounted to RMB76,691 million, representing an increase of 0.37% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year.

## 6. Development of Infrastructure and Other Investment Projects

The contract value of all businesses from infrastructure and other investment projects confirmed according to the shareholding ratio of the Company amounted to RMB88,542 million (of which RMB80,089 million from domestic and RMB8,453 million from overseas), representing a decrease of 31.57% as compared to that for the corresponding period of last year. During the process of design and construction, the value of construction and installation contracts to be undertaken by the Group is estimated to be RMB75,377 million.

## II. MAJOR CONTRACTS SIGNED

The major contracts signed by the Group from October to December 2025 refer to the contracts each of which accounted for more than 10% of the value of the contracts for its involved business segment or project type in the quarter with a contract amount of above RMB100 million.
